Parents Right-to-Know
(Teacher Qualifications • Not-Highly-Qualified Status)

- (A) QUALIFICATIONS- At the beginning of each school year Learning Foundation and Performing Arts shall notify the parents of each student attending that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers, including, at a minimum, the following:
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
 - Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
- (B) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION- In addition to the information that parents may request the school shall provide the following to each individual parent . . .
- Information on the level of achievement of the parent's child in each of the state's academic assessments.
 - Timely notice that the parent's child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not hold a baccalaureate degree major or any other graduate certification or degree.
